Activities

- 1) Try a hidden transmitter (fox) hunt on these frequencies (in parking lot)
 - Easy 433.915
 - Moderate 433.845
 - Bear Hunt 447.800 (radio tracking to corner a moving ham operator)
- 2) Try the All States CQ Contest (between rooms in the building).
 - Important! In each room pick a favorite state and frequency for that room.
 - listen on different frequencies to find states to contact (other rooms).
 - Call CQ or answer CQ messages to make a contact.
 - Mark on each state the name of the person you contacted.
 - Keep a running tally of the number of states and contacts you've made.
 - Use these frequencies for making state-to-state contacts (between rooms):
